# Jury says local man guilty of child sex

WILKES-BARRE — A Newport Township man was convicted Friday in Luzerne County Court of sexually assaulting the 10-year-old daughter of his girifriend.

The jury acquitted him of indecent exposure and two counts of aggravated indecent assault.

Bath was charged with assaulting the girl in her mother's home in Glen Lyon in March.

It is the Times Leader's policy not to publish the names of victims of alleged sexual assault.

Both the victim and Bath testifled at the trial held before Senior Judge Bernard Podcasy.

The judge ordered Bath returned to Luzerne County Correctional Facility where he has been held for lack of \$25,000 ball since his arrest in March.

The judge told Bath that he has 10 days to file a petition for a new trial.

Assistant district attorney Jim Phillips prosecuted the case. Assistant public defender John Sobota represented Bath.



The following information is provided should you desire a review by the Northeast Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.

- 1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to the regional director, Northeast Region, BSA. In your request you may include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that your registration should not have been denied.
- 2. Upon receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
- 3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
- 5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.
