To Whot It May Concern:

This supplement to the attached form APPRNDIX A, CONFIDENTIAL RECORD SHEET is not pleasant to write. It concerns our desire to recommend denial of reregistration of one of our most valued Scoutmasters for the past eight years.

What I report is a summation from his estranged wife, plus her statement, signed, and additional material from the local rape aid organization.

Jack Henry Stettenbauer married twelve-and-a-half years ago. It was the second marriage for each. Jack brought one natural son to the new marriage, who now resides in Reading, Pennsylvania.

has one child and marriage is being dissolved - she is under the care of a psychiatrist, trying to erase the emotional scars from earlier incest/molestation by her stenfather.

28, 19, a recent graduate of U.S. Navy boot camp. Eagle Scout 15, currently in Troop 129, also undergoing psychiatric care to enable him to cope with school and his peers in the troop.

About a year ago Jack Stettenbauer and began a sexual relationship, resulting in both being the cause of divorce proceedings. It is a local chiropractor. (He gave his wife an ultimatum - break off the relationship with Jack or I will file for divorce. She refused. The divorce proceedings are now underway.) Jack filed for divorce; contested; now she has dropped her protest and that divorce is proceeding.

Both Jack and attended weekly Troop meetings together, and accompanied the Troop on various trips and campouts. The Committee Chairman resigned; Jack resigned as S.M., became Asst. S.M., appointed as Chairman and the Troop started its plunge downward.



Seeing the turmoil of their younger brother, and mother, the two daughters finally told their mother of the sexual molestation that took place as they were growing up. It is now well past five years since both girls have left home, and as I indicated previously, marriage is on the rocks and she is finally coming to grips with her own sexuality, under the careful care of her spiritual advisor and psychiatrist.

With this additional information, we were the went into deep depression, ending up in St. Joseph Hospital, Lancaster, and its psychiatric care unit, on the verge of taking her own life. She abandoned God - feeling with certainty in her heart that if there were a God, He had abandoned her.

She is now learning to cope. Son is learning to cope. Now that this added data has all surfaceed, she does not want Jack to be able to register again in Scouting, We certainly agree.

This resume has been read back to to verify its accuracy. The additional enclosures should sum up this tragic happening.

Please also undetsrand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.
