Cherry, of the 2700 block of Taunton Street in Northeast Philadelphia, was also ordered by Montgomery County Judge William T. Nicholas to undergo psychiatric evaluation and his teaching license was permanently revoked, said James Markofski, Montgomery County assistant district attorney.

Cherry had been charged last year with six counts of corrupting the morals of children after allegations that he sexually molested six boys who attended a camp during 1987 and 1988 that Cherry owned in Lower Gwynedd Township, Montgomery County. Two of the charges were subsequently dropped, Markofski said.

U.S. judge reduces damages for ex-officers in bias case

A federal judge has reduced damages from \$395,000 to \$165,000 for two women after a jury found their civil rights were violated by a pattern of sexual harassment while they were officers in the Philadelphia Police Department.

U.S. District Judge Clarence C. Newcomer ruled that a jury verdict Dec. 19 against the city "cannot stand." Newcomer denied a jury award of \$130,000 to Priscilla Kelsey-Andrews and \$100,000 to Debra Conn

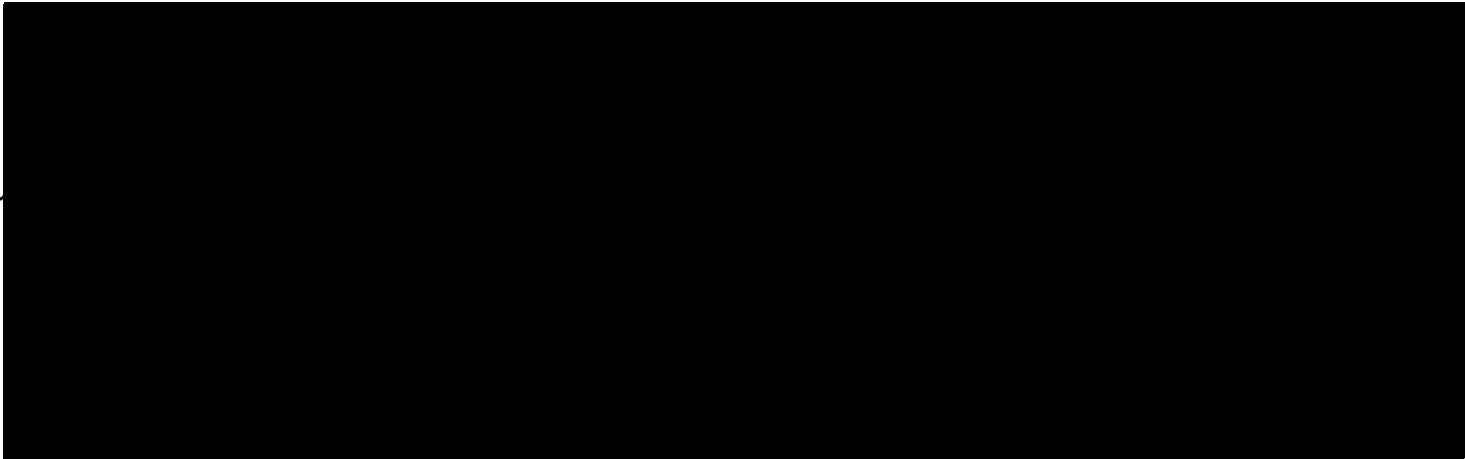



Teacher is arrested in morals case

A Neshaminy Junior High School teacher was arrested last night at his Northeast Philadelphia home after reports that he sexually molested a 3-year-old boy and four teenage Boy Scouts attending his day camp in Lower Gwynedd Township, Montgomery County, police said.

Robert Cherry, 48, of the 2700 block of Taunton Street, was expected to be taken to the Police Administration Building at Eighth and Race Streets and to be transferred later to Gwynedd Township for arraignment, authorities said.

Cherry was to be charged with five counts of corrupting the morals of a minor, township investigators said.

He owns the Spring House Country Day Camp, a 40-acre facility on McKean Road, and also is an eighth-grade math teacher and a troop leader for Montgomery County Boy Scout Troop 656, which meets at Sandy Hill Middle School in Dresher.

Lower Gwynedd Detective Ronald Lynch said police issued an arrest warrant after the mother of a 15-year-old boy reported to a Montgomery County police department that Cherry sexually abused her son Feb. 20 during an overnight ski trip at Camp Laurel in the Poconos.

Lynch said the boy — who was in Cherry's scout troop — did not tell his mother about the incident until last week. Afterward, three other teenage scouts came forward with similar complaints.

Police said the 3-year-old boy was registered in the camp's kindergarten program. The boy came home from a day at the camp and told his mother that "someone was touching me," according to a police complaint.

Investigators said most of the incidents reportedly occurred last summer in the camp's main building during overnight outings. All the boys were residents of the eastern Montgomery County area, and some have left Cherry's troop, police said.

Edward Hancock, Lower Gwynedd police chief, said the scout troop had a history of boys abruptly quitting. He said he was investigating to determine whether other incidents of sexual abuse might have occurred.

Because of the allegations, the Boy Scout troop will be reorganized, said Albert Smith, council executive for the Valley Forge Council of the Boy Scouts of America. The council is the governing body for more than 500 troops in Delaware and Montgomery Counties.

"Of course he is out as a leader," Smith said of Cherry.

Scout Master, Camp Owner, Is Arrested on Morals Charge

The owner of a Spring House day camp was arrested today on charges that he allegedly sexually assaulted four teen-agers and a three-year-old boy at the camp, Lower Gwynedd Township police said.

Robert Cherry, 48, of the 2700 block of Taunton Street, Northeast Philadelphia, was arrested by Philadelphia police early this morning at his home, according to Lower Gwynedd Police Chief Edward Hancock.

Hancock said Cherry will be transported to Lower Gwynedd today and will be arraigned before District Justice John S. Murray III of Blue Bell.

Cherry, a junior high school teacher, will be charged with five counts each of corrupting minors and indecent assault, according to reports.

The incidents occurred at the Spring House Country Day Camp on McKean Road between 1985 and the present, police said. They said Cherry owns the camp.

According to the criminal complaint, Cherry sexually assaulted the four teen-agers, ranging in age from 13 to 16,

numerous times while on overnight trips at the camp.

Some of the boys reported being assaulted as many as 10 to 15 times, police said, and many of the incidents occurred last summer.

The teen-agers, all of Eastern Montgomery County, were members of Boy Scout Troop 656 of Dresher and Cherry was their scout master, police said.

The three-year-old boy told his mother last summer that someone had been touching him, according to the criminal complaint. The three-year-old belonged to the day camp's kindergarten program, reports stated.

A fifth teen-ager, 13, told police he was never indecently assaulted, but Cherry would tell him how much he loved having the youth around.

During a discussion last week between Cherry and the father of one of the youths, Cherry admitted that he had a sexual problem and had assaulted a youth more than a year ago.
