Former scoutmaster admits he sexually abused 3 boys

A former Lenigh County scoutmaster yesterday pleaded guilty to charges that he had sexual contact with three boys in his Boy Scout troop.

William L. Symons, 30, of New Tripoli R.3, pleaded guilty to statutory rape involving a boy who was about 12 years old when the incident occurred and pleaded guilty to two counts of indecent assault involving two 13-year-olds.

Lehigh County Judge James N. Diefenderfer scheduled sentencing for June 16 and ordered that Dr. Paul Gross do a psychiatric evaluation of Symons.

The rape charge stemmed from incidents that occurred between January 1980 and June 1983, according to Assistant District Attorney John Waldron, who said the acts took place outside the boy's house and inside the house when the boy's parents were not home.

The indecent assault charges stemmed from incidents on Nov. 11, 1985.

As part of a negotiated plea, the sentences on the three charges are to run concurrently. Symons faces a

maximum sentence of five to 10 years in prison for his plea to statutory rape.

Symons, who resigned as a scoutmaster Dec. 1, had been scoutmaster for the Minsi Trails Council Boy Scout Troop No. 89, Waldron said.

He said the incidents were reported to state police at Bethlehem after the parents of one of the 13-year-old boys noticed that their son was spending an inordinate amount of time with Symons.

The parents became suspicious and questioned the boy about his relationship with Symons, Waldron said.

Police said that Symons forced one of the boys to touch his genital area and that he touched one of the boys.

Symons remains free on \$3,000 cash bail.

He was arrested Jan. 7 by state police at Bethlehem and was arraigned before District Justice Edward E. Hartman of Slatington.

Symons is represented by Allentown attorney Marc Kranson.

The police prosecutor is Trooper Joseph A. Vazquez of the Bethlehem barracks.
